REGISTER USING A WEB BROWSER

If you've created an account in the past, you've got a start for this year! If this is your first time using Beanstack and you need to create an account, it's fast and easy to do by following the steps on the Beanstack landing page: https://blufftonpubliclibrary.beanstack.org

- Click Register an Individual or Family.
- Click I am registering myself and fill out the form.
- Click **Next** to add additional family members.
- Register for the age appropriate **2022 Summer Reading Challenge Oceans of Possibilities**.
- Begin tracking your reading and activities by clicking on **Log Reading and Activities** at the top of the page.

REGISTER USING THE BEANSTACK APP

- Download **Beanstack** app (available from your app store)
- Tap Find Your School or Library.
- Type in "Bluffton Public Library".
- If you have an account, Sign In.
- If not, tap Sign Up! Enter a User Name and Password
- Follow the prompts to complete the Registration for **YOU**.
- Tap Add a Reader for additional family members.
- Tap Challenges at the bottom of the screen and register for the age appropriate 2022 Summer Reading Challenge.
- When ready to log reading or to check out activities, tap on the 2022 Summer Reading Challenge in the app, and then tap the "+" to log your **Reading, Activities or Reviews**.

NOTES:

*Paper Log Option: There is a Badge Book available for K-5 (while supplies last) and paper reading logs for 6th-12th grade and for Adults for those who would prefer that alternative. Stop by the front desk to receive the book/log designed for your age group! Paper logs will also be available on our website to print from home. Drop completed logs off at the library on or before July 31 to be included in grand prize drawings.

Children PreK or younger are encouraged to participate in our 1000 Books Before Kindergarten program. Pick up a paper reading and activity log at the library front desk and return the completed log by July 31 to be included in prize drawings. New to 1000 Books Before Kindergarten? Sign up at the front desk to receive a free bag, board book, and packet of ideas for what to read next upon registration.
